



Topic: Management Tools for Slip, Trip and Fall Avoidance

General Safety Tips

- Build a formal slip, trip and fall (STF) program tailored to your operations, including training, footwear protocols, housekeeping, hazard assessments and supervisor development.
- Reinforce expectations such as no rushing and provide ongoing reminders through safety meetings.
- Implement structured housekeeping practices like 5S to maintain clean, organized work areas.
- Use continuous improvement methods such as Kaizen and Six Sigma to systematically reduce risks.

Topics to Discuss

- Evaluate your current STF program to identify gaps and opportunities for improvement.
- Consider technology solutions, such as virtual AI camera assessments, to help identify hazards.
- Partner with footwear vendors to provide approved slip-resistant options for employees.
- Explore adding physical capability assessments for new hires.
- Strengthen visual safety messaging with posters, signage and digital displays.
- Encourage employee involvement in identifying hazards and selecting improvement actions.
